^{*}EISENHOWER GOLF CLUB GUEST DRESS CODE: Collared shirts preferred, tee shirts are allowed with minimal designs or graphics. Women golfers may wear sleeveless golf style shirts, shorts or skirts shall be at least mid-thigh in length. Sandals may be worn if manufactured for the purpose of golfing, tennis shoes and other soft soled shoes are allowed as well. The following

items of clothing are not allowed: Tank tops, midriff shirts Cut off shorts, bathing suit tops or bottoms. Flip Flops, shoes with heels, any shoe with spikes not intended for golf. Any obscene, profane, or abusive designs or logos. There are clean, collared shirts for loan if guest has no appropriate shirts to wear.


**BUSINESS CASUAL clothing options for men might include:

- Business dress pants, khakis, or pressed slacks
- Button-down shirts, dress shirts, sweaters, or polo shirts
- Closed-toed shoes such as lifestyle sneakers, loafers, oxfords, or brogues
- Optional belt that matches your shoes
- Optional tie and jacket, cardigan, or sport coat, especially for added warmth during colder months

BUSINESS CASUAL clothing options for women might include:

- Slacks, khaki pants, chinos, or knee-length skirts
- Blouses, sweaters, button-downs, Henley's or polo shirts
- Knee-length or maxi dresses
- Optional hosiery or tights, especially for added warmth during colder months
- Optional cardigans, blazers, or jackets
- Closed-toed shoes such as lifestyle sneakers, loafers, oxfords, pumps, flats or boots
- Simple, professional accessories such as scarves, belts, or jewelry

Other Falcon Stadium requirements (this is a summary, see https://goairforcefalcons.com):

- 1. You can bring a handbag as long as it is no larger than 12"x12"x12" and not hard-sided or a cooler. It is subject to search. No backpacks, bota bags, wine-skins, or camelbacks. Infant diaper bags/carrier packs allowed only if an infant is present.
- 2. Water is permitted but must be in a factory-sealed transparent water bottle, 24oz or less. (Those with medical conditions or with infants can be excepted from the only water policy). Or you can bring an empty transparent soft water bottle and fill it inside.
- 3. Food is permitted, but must be in a 1-gallon transparent zip lock bag (1 per ticketholder)
- 4. No signs that have not been pre-approved and all approved signs must be no larger than 18" x 24".
- 5. No seatbacks wider than 19" and no excessive pockets or protruding arm rests.
- 6. No flash photography, artificial noisemakers, balls, Frisbees, umbrellas, etc. and no throwing of any objects.
- 7. No illegal substances (Marijuana is illegal on Federal property), weapons or dangerous objects of any type.
